

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND ADMISSION PROCEDURE TO THE GNM COURSE OF VKNRL SCHOOL OF NURSING, 2020

1. Minimum eligibility criteria for admission to GNM

- Applicant must be a female candidate.
- Candidates must be a citizen of India
- 10+2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% marks in at the qualifying examination and English individually from any recognized board. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School. However Science is preferable.
- Age: Candidates must be within the age limit of 17 to 35 years as on 31.12.2020.
- Registered ANM
- Candidate should be medically fit.

2. Reservation

- a) For disabled candidates: 5% disability reservation to be considered with a disability of locomotor to the tune of 40% to 50% of the lower extremity and other eligibility criteria with regard to age and qualification will be same as prescribed for nursing programme.
- b) 5% of total marks are relaxed for SC/ST candidates.
- c) Seat reservation as per Govt. of Assam (SC-7%,ST(P)-10%,ST(H)-5%,OBC/MOBC-15%, EWS-10%,). In case of unavailability of suitable candidates from the reserved categories, the vacant seats will be filled up by the candidates from the open merit list.
- d) 30% of the seats shall be reserved for the candidates from 10 KM radius of Numaligargh Refinery Limited (Schooling from school covered under Gyandeeep Scheme), 30% of the seats shall be reserved from Golaghat District and 40% of the seats is open for all. In case of non-availability of suitable candidates from 10 km radius of Numaligargh Refinery Limited, these seats shall be filled from the merit list of Golaghat District and in case of non-availability of suitable candidates from Golaghat District; the same shall be filled from open merit list.

3. Selection Process

- Selection shall be based on the percentage of marks scored in the qualifying examination and Entrance Examination. In case of Science stream students, 7% marks shall be added to the percentage of marks obtained in their qualifying examination.
- The provisional list, taking all criterions into consideration, shall be prepared and published in the school website at <http://www.vknrlnursingschool.edu.in> latest by 18th December 2020.
- The candidates selected for admission will have to undergo medical examination by a medical board consisting of Doctor/faculty members of the institute. If in the assessment of the medical board, a candidate is found medically unfit, she will not be allowed to take admission in the course. The institute will also cancel the admission even if a candidate is diagnosed with major disease within 3 (three) months of admission.
- As any changes made in the admission process will be uploaded in the website.

- Candidates once admitted in the GNM course will not be permitted to pursue any other course of studies simultaneously and will automatically forfeit the GNM seats if they do so.

4. Criteria for Rejection of Application Forms

- a. Candidates who fail to fulfill the age criterion.
- b. Candidates who fail to obtain the minimum stipulated marks in the qualifying examination (ANM / 10 + 2 etc.).
- c. Candidates fail to obtain minimum of 40 marks in subject ENGLISH in the last qualifying exam.
- d. Faulty submission, Non-submission of documents, low visibility of documents and incomplete details in the online application Forms and submission of incomplete documents or non- receipt of Examination Fee.

5. Admission Process

- i. Candidates whose names appear in the provisional selection list, based on selection process stated above, will be called for documents verification and medical checkup. A final list of selected candidates will be prepared for the admission. (The candidate has to bring original documents, photo copy of all submitted documents (2 sets) and 2 copies of recent passport size photo).
- ii. Candidate selected shall have to pay the fee/dues, etc. on the day of admission, failing which her selection shall be treated as cancelled and seat will be offered to the next candidate on the waiting list in order of merit.
- iii. Selected candidates who have been admitted but failed to join the course within a week after the commencement of the academic session shall automatically forfeit their seat and no correspondence shall be entertained.
- iv. Each Candidate admitted to the Institute will have to give an undertaking counter-signed by parents/legal guardian, that she shall maintain good conduct, pay the requisite fees and other charges by the scheduled date, attend classes regularly and abide by the rules and regulations of the Institute failing which she is likely to be suspended or terminated as a student of the Institute.
